**ASSESSMENT SERVICES:**

- DUI Assessment:**       English or  Spanish Speaking Services  
 **Substance Abuse Evaluation:**  AAP Prostitution Evaluation,  Family Court or  Criminal Court

**CRIMINAL JUSTICE TREATMENT SERVICES:**

- (BADD)- Basic Alcohol/Drug Diversion:** (First Time Offenders Program, 12 weeks)  
 **(RID)- Reducing Intoxicated Drivers:** (Repeat Alcohol Offender: Recidivism Reduction Program)  
 **(DDDT)- Do Drugs Do Time:** (Repeat Drug Offender -Recidivism Reduction Program)  
 **Criminal Thinking (Impulse Control) Program:** 12-24 week program for adolescents and adults, designed to challenge and correct irresponsible criminal thinking and behavior, 1 ½ hours per week  
 **Anger Management/Coping Skills Program:** 12-week program for adolescents and adults, 1 ½ hours per week.  
 **Johns School:** 8 hour prostitution and solicitation reduction program

**DUI (ADSAC) SCHOOLS/VICTIMS IMPACT PANEL:**

- 10 Hour (ADSAC) DUI School:** Weekend DUI School, completed in 3-days  
 **24 Hour (ADSAC) DUI School:** 6-week DUI School, weekend and evening classes  
 **Victims Impact Panel:** One 2-hr. session, facilitated by (MADD) Mothers Against Drunk Driving

**CO-OCCURRING AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT SERVICES:**

- Early Intervention Programs:** 6-week substance abuse education program for adults and 12-week substance abuse education program for adolescents. Random Drug Testing provided (if UA referral form completed)  
 **Outpatient Adolescent Programs:** 6-24 week program for adolescents. Individual, group, family and substance abuse education services provided. Self-help meeting attendance and random drug testing is required.  
 **Intensive Outpatient Adolescent Programs:** 12 week program (9-12 hours per week) and 6-weeks of aftercare. Individual, group, family and substance abuse education services provided. Self-help meeting attendance and random drug testing is required.  
 **Outpatient Adult Programs:** 6-24 week program for adults. Individual, group, family and substance abuse education services provided. Self-help meeting attendance and random drug testing is required.  
 **Intensive Outpatient Adult Programs:** 12 week program (9-12 hours per week) and 6-weeks of aftercare. Individual, group, family and substance abuse education services provided. Self-help meeting attendance and random drug testing is required.  
 **Relapse Prevention/Aftercare Programs:**  6-week program  12-week program

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**SPECIALIZED TREATMENT SERVICES:**

- Amethyst House:** Women's Sober House and Outpatient Treatment (90-days to 1 year stay)
- (SFP) - Strengthening Families Program:** SFP is a "Free" outpatient program presented in a 14 week format with highly structured, consecutive weekly sessions, each lasting approximately 2 hours. Which is aimed at "Treating the Whole Family" (Parents and Children), to help heal, implement a recovery based model and assist in family reunification for your clients.
- Positive Parenting Program:** A "Free" outpatient program for pregnant mothers who have been or who are struggling with substance abuse presented in a 12 week format with highly structured, consecutive weekly sessions, each lasting approximately 1.5 hours. Areas of focus: nutrition, employment, GED, money management, vocational training, WIC, infant crisis services, recovery based services, etc...
- Impaired Professionals Program:** 12-week to 6 month outpatient treatment set up for working professionals (attorneys, nurses, doctors and other professionals who are struggling with addiction and desire a life of sobriety. Individual, Group, Family and Aftercare Services Provided. Self-help meeting attendance is required. Random Drug Testing required.
- Opiate Addiction Program:** 12-week to 6 month intensive outpatient medication assisted treatment program set up for individuals who are struggling with opiate addiction (loritab, heroin, oxycontin, oxycodone, etc). Individual, Group, Family and Aftercare Services Provided. Medication assistance (Dr. visits required). Self-help meeting attendance is required. Random Drug Testing required.
